Three Arrested for Throwing Red Eggs

NEW YORK (UPI)—Three New Jersey men, believed to be Cuban refugees, were arrested Wednesday night for bombarding the Cuban mission to the United Nations with dozens of egg shells filled with red paint. Police said the three apparently had drawn out the yolk and white of the eggs with a needle and filled the shells with the paint. The cause of the egg-throwing was not immediately determined, police said. The men were arrested after a two-block foot-chase from the mission. The men, who were charged with disorderly conduct and malicious mischief, gave Elizabeth, N.J., as their address. All three were born in Cuba, police said. Police said at least two more men escaped after the incident.

West Germans to Seek Sex Measure

BONN (UPI)—The West German government may seek authorization to castrate convicted sex criminals, Justice Minister Ewald Bucher said Wednesday. Bucher told Parliament that the chief obstacle was the present law which provides that castration may be undertaken only if the subject agrees. He said the criminal code now is undergoing revision, and that the law should be changed. He said there were 4,538 convictions in West Germany for sexual attacks on children in 1961, the last year for which statistics were available.

President's Father Visits White House

WASHINGTON (UPI)—Former Ambassador to Britain Joseph P. Kennedy is visiting his son, the President, at the White House. The elder Kennedy, ailing since he suffered a stroke Dec. 19, 1961, arrived Wednesday aboard the family plane, the Caroline, accompanied by his niece and companion, Ann Caran of Boston.

Etruscan Art Found in Well

ROME (UPI)—At some time in the Middle Ages, people living in a village northwest of Rome apparently found the remains of a small Etruscan temple and, with the religious intolerance typical of the period, proceeded to destroy it. They threw everything that was left of the temple into a well and sealed it with huge stone blocks. It stayed that way until Dr. Lucia Portoghesi, slim, dark-haired young archaeologist, brought out a crew of workmen recently and dug up two of the most interesting items of Etruscan art found in modern times. They are frescoes of Etruscan warriors and dancers, painted on terra cotta about 2,500 years ago. Dr. Portoghesi, who works for the Superintendent of Antiquities of Southern Etruria, said the style of painting is completely different than that of other Etruscan funerary art found previously in the same area. Dr. Portoghesi made her discoveries at Corti, a few miles from Cerveteri, the famous burial site of the mysterious Etruscan peoples, whose extensive excavations were carried out in the 1930's.
