

Banquet Planned for Ladies Auxiliary

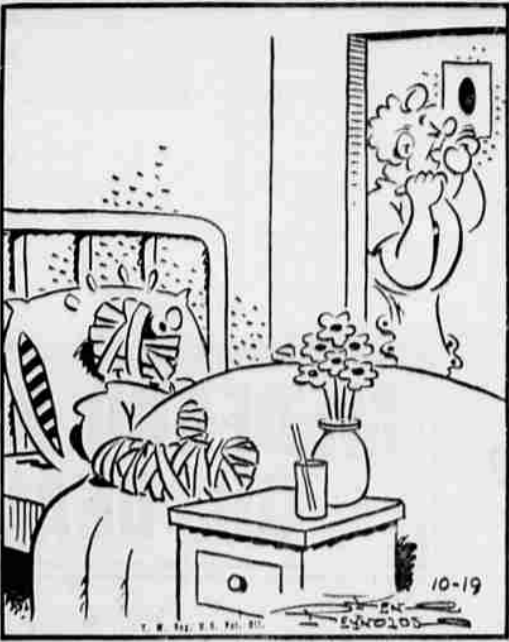

Patrick Graham, "chef de cuisine extraordinaire," will prepare the dinner, which will be served at 6:30 p.m.

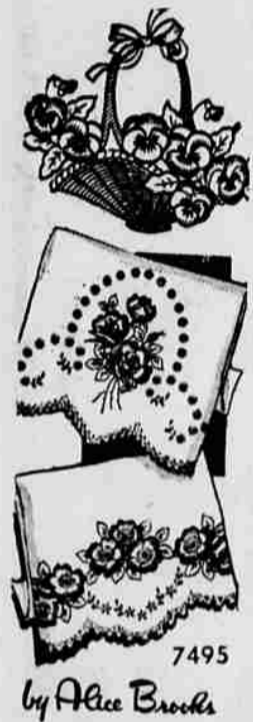
The auxiliary has been vacationing from meetings since Aug. 1.

Area Retirees Invited To Florida Community

Charles D. Wiley, Medford secretary of the local branch 1433, National Association of Letter Carriers, has announced that retirees of the Medford area have been invited to join letter carriers at their new Florida retirement community, NALCREST.

The retirement community was originally constructed as a retirement home for letter carriers only. The letter carriers enlarged the scope of the project to include other retirees of the community.

The \$4 1/2 million, self-contained community in central Florida, has its own shopping center, post office, 500-seat auditorium, marina, swimming pool, with cabanas, and all other services considered necessary to modern living.

In addition, Wiley pointed out, the community has 1,300 feet of private lake frontage and facilities for some of the best fishing and hunting to be found in the United States. It encompasses 150 acres and contains 500 apartment units. One bedroom apartments are available.

United Nations Week Proclaimed

Medford Mayor James J. Dunlevy has issued proclamations urging observance of United Nations Week, Oct. 20-26, and calling upon Medford citizens to participate in Trick or Treat for UNICEF Oct. 31.

In designating Oct. 24 as United Nations Day, Dunlevy said: "In this age there seems no rational alternative but to develop an effective system of collective security under the auspices of a community of nations such as the peace-keeping machinery of the United Nations."

The mayor urged Medford residents to take part in local UN activities scheduled during the week.

Mayor Dunlevy called Trick or Treat for UNICEF "a constructive expression of American children's concern and friendship for their less fortunate contemporaries."

"The United Nations Children's Fund is helping millions of children and mothers to better health in 100 countries and territories by assisting government in programs of disease control, nutrition, and maternal and child welfare," Dunlevy said.
