

Louisiana Negro Voter Registration Attempt Continues

By AL KUETTNER United Press International This is another chapter of the Louisiana story. Chapter heading: Voter Registration. The Mystery: Which side in the story would prevail when the drama is completed.

Are they being intimidated from voting? Some Negroes say yes. Officials say no. The federal courts probably will decide, following suits from the Justice Department and a study by the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

Target Of Drive East Feliciana Parish where Clinton is the county seat and West Feliciana with St. Francisville as the seat have been the targets in recent weeks of a concerted Negro voter registration drive conducted with the help of the Congress of Racial Equality (CORE). The net result so far is about 100 Negroes registered in East Feliciana where there are 4,102 Negroes

Some Negroes were claiming that intimidation was at the root of the lack of registration enthusiasm.

James A. Payne, a 41-year-old Negro, said a trio of white men came to his home, fired two shots into the ground between his feet and threatened to kill him if he sought to register.

Payne did not turn up Monday, a CORE spokesman said it was because he was at a hospital for treatment of a face wound said to have been inflicted when hit with a shotgun by a white man.

No Formal Complaints Sheriff William C. Percy said, however, that he has had no formal complaints of any threats against Payne. Federal agents were observing the registration scene.

In East Feliciana next door, white leaders blamed CORE for producing racial turmoil that could cost lives.

James H. Cox, a three-judge federal court panel last week he had never heard of anybody being deprived of their voting rights in that parish.

Civil rights spokesmen said another voting suit probably will be filed with the Justice Department, one of a growing number of such cases now hitting east and north Louisiana.
