A Salem man was sentenced to five years in the Oregon State Penitentiary this week on a charge of shoplifting.

He had pleaded guilty to taking articles from Sears Roebuck and Company store Sept. 20.

Sentenced by Circuit Judge Edward C. Kelly was George Henry Schreiber, 57, of 4300 Commercial St. Salem.

Prior to sentencing Judge Kelly commented on statements made by District Attorney Alan B. Holmes, calling Schreiber a "professional shoplifter."
