

Southern Oregon College Site of Student Meeting

ASHLAND — The Southern Oregon College campus will be the site of the 1963 Oregon Federation of Collegiate Leaders convention Nov. 8 and 9.

The convention will open Friday, Nov. 8, with a luncheon in the SOC commons. The afternoon agenda will include discussion topics ranging from philosophies of student government

to more specific areas of campus fund raising.

Friday evening will feature a kickoff banquet with an opening address by Jim Armon, SOC assistant dean of men, and a keynote speech by Dr. Francis Nickerson, dean of student affairs at the University of Oregon. Dr. Nickerson's speech will exploit the role of student gov-

ernment in higher education.

The conclave will reopen Saturday morning with additional discussion groups and business meetings, followed by the election of next year's executive committee. The convention will close with dinner Saturday evening.

The Oregon Federation of Collegiate Leaders was designed several years ago to foster and promote friendly, cordial institutional relations among the public and private colleges within the state and among the student leaders of the institutions.

The Federation is currently comprised of 13 active members: University of Oregon, Oregon State University, Portland State College, Southern Oregon College, Oregon Technical Institute, Oregon College of Education, Eastern Oregon College, Lewis and Clark, University of Portland, Pacific University, George Fox College, Willamette University and Linfield College.

Purposes of Federation

The Federation strives to acquaint individual student leaders of the institutions with one another, promotes sharing and exchange of divergent philosophies of student government, attempts to contribute in the ways and means to better student activities on the campuses, and serves as the central vehicle in the unification of the Oregon colleges and universities toward concepts of mutual concern.

The task of administering the policies of the Federation between the annual conventions rests with an executive committee composed of a president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer-host. The current officers are president, Phil Sherburn, University of Oregon; vice president, Dick Foster, George Fox College; secretary, Nadine Herala, Oregon College of Education; and treasurer-host Frank Alessio, Southern Oregon College.

IT'S YOUR LAW

Respect for Law Makes Democracy Live

ABSTRACTS

While driving around a lake, John and Mary saw a "For Sale" sign on a piece of lake property which they thought they could afford to buy.

They made inquiry of the owner and agreed on a price. They inquired about title and the owner assured them that he would give them "an abstract". They took the abstract, which was a fat book of papers, and the deed, filed the deed at the courthouse and thought no more about it, assuming, as many people do, that "an abstract" is an assurance of good title.

Better Informed

Some years later they went to sell to a buyer who was better informed who insisted that either the abstract be examined and an opinion given that the title was good or they must provide title insurance. When they inquired about getting an opinion as to whether the abstract showed good title, they were dismayed to find that the opinion was going to be expensive. They went to a title company and were told that its

records showed the title was not in good order, and there would have to be a quiet-title lawsuit to dispose of some flaws in the title.

Wrong in Assumption

John and Mary were astounded to learn they were wrong in assuming that "an abstract" was an assurance of good title. An abstract is merely a copy of every document which has ever been filed of record at the courthouse affecting the title to a particular piece of property. It may show good title or bad title, or no title at all. Until it has been examined by someone who can render a competent opinion, it is only a bundle of papers, as John and Mary discovered.
