**NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER FOR SALE**  
West River blowdown  
Oral auction bids will be received by the Forest Supervisor, Post Office Building, Medford, Oregon beginning at 10:00 A.M. December 2, 1963, for all merchantable timber marked or designated for cutting on an area embracing 300 acres more or less, within sections 6 and 7, T. 30 S., R. 4 E., sections 1, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, and 24, T. 30 S., R. 4 E., W.M. surveyed in the Rogue River National Forest, Douglas and Jackson Counties, Oregon. The estimated volumes are: 489 M board feet of Douglas-fir; 760 M board feet of sugar pine; western white pine, and ponderosa pine; 730 M board feet of white fir and other species. The minimum acceptable bid per M board feet is as follows: Douglas-fir \$28.25; sugar pine, western white pine, and ponderosa pine \$37.95; white fir and other species \$19.00. This includes the stumpage rate, per M board feet for stumpage including deposit for sale area betterment of \$24.35 plus an additional \$2.80 for Douglas-fir; \$23.80 base rate plus an additional \$11.03 for sugar pine, western white pine, and ponderosa pine; \$8.25 base rate plus an additional \$1.15 for white fir and other species and \$1.10 for slash disposal for all species. In addition there is within the sale area an estimated volume of Douglas-fir, logs and peeler blocks unmerchantable because of defect which the bidder may agree to remove at \$0.50 per M board feet, gross scale. The prices bid for stumpage shall be subject to quarterly calendar adjustment upward or downward by 0.5 of the difference between the Region Index, as calculated by the Forest Service or the Western Pine Association Lumber Price Index, for the three previous months, and the following base indices: Douglas-fir, \$18.76; sugar pine, western white pine, and ponderosa pine 109.67; white fir and other species \$50.94. Such adjustments in the price for stumpage shall be applicable to timber sealed during the three-month period following the quarter for which the adjustment is computed. In no event, however, shall the payment rates for each quarter be less than the base rates as stated above. When the adjusted rates by species are lower than the base rates, the difference between the total dollar value of timber cut at adjusted rates and at base rates will be recorded for each species. The stumpage rate for any species will not be increased above the base rate until the subsequent adjusted rates above base rates develop an accumulated total dollar value in excess of the recorded accumulated difference for all species. Sealed bids will be publicly opened and posted, at the office of the Forest Supervisor, Medford, Oregon, at 10:00 A.M. on December 16, 1963. All those who submitted a satisfactory sealed bid will be permitted immediately to continue auction bidding. A money order, bank draft, cashier's or certified check in the sum of \$3,000.00 must accompany each bid, to be applied to the purchase price, refunded or retained for application to any claim for damages, according to the conditions of sale. If requested, the value of the performance bond. If an oral bid is declared to be high at the closing of the auction, the bidder must immediately confirm the oral bid by submitting it in writing on a Forest Service bid form. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Forest Service sealed bids and full information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale and the submission of bids should be obtained from the District Ranger, Union Creek Ranger Station, Prospect, Oregon, or the Forest Supervisor, Medford, Oregon, before bids are submitted.

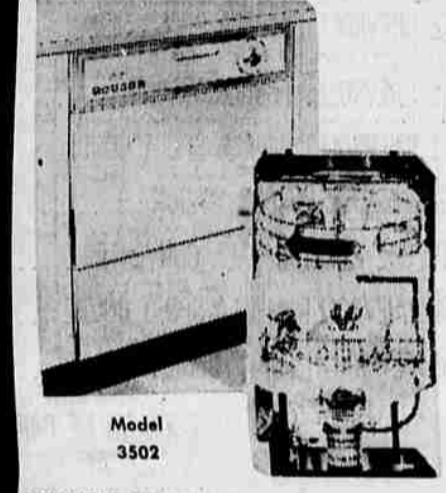

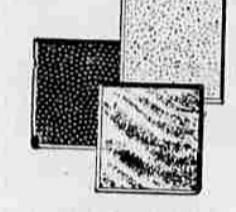
