Three Killed in CAP Plane Crash

LINDENHURST, N. Y. (UPI)—A Civil Air Patrol (CAP) plane carrying three persons crashed in flames into two houses and three cars Saturday shortly after taking off from a small airfield.

Those aboard the plane were killed. Four persons on the ground, including a 12-year-old boy, were injured. The dead were not immediately identified. The injured were Stanley Kota, 38, critical condition with head and rib injuries; his son, Stephen, 12, lacerations of the head and multiple leg injuries; Virgil Krist, 35, serious condi-
