Explosions Heard In Tuscaloosa, Ala.

Authorities today investigated two weekend explosions which shattered windows in a Negro neighborhood at Tuscaloosa, Ala., and jolted a University of Alabama dormitory where the

school's only Negro student resides. Nobody was injured in the blasts, which occurred about 18 hours apart.

Gov. George C. Wallace advanced the theory that they may have been pranks of high-spirited students caught up in the enthusiasm of Saturday's Alabama-Georgia Tech football game. The first blast occurred at 3:10 a.m. Saturday and ripped a hole in a campus street near Mary Burke Hall where Negro Vivian Malone resides. The second explosion occurred at 9:38 p.m. behind a grocery in a Negro section of the university town and shattered windows in the area.

Other developments: Williamston, N.C.: Seven of 15 white New England ministers arrested during an anti-segregation demonstration chose to remain in jail here today as a continuing protest against the town's racial policies.

Statesville, N.C.: The Rev. James P. Dees, a local Episcopal minister, announced that he was breaking away from the church and forming a separate religious organization with segregated services and more fundamental teachings. New York: The United Presbyterian Church disclosed Sunday it plans to discontinue financial dealings with companies that practice racial discrimination.

Jackson, Miss.: Ten integrationists tried unsuccessfully to enter white Methodist churches here Sunday and were arrested when they refused to leave. Bayville, La.: About 6,000 hooded Ku Klux Klansmen attended a weekend rally here and heard their leaders exhort them to undertake a campaign against national television

shows that "exaggerated the use of Negroes in their casts and advertising."

Chester, Pa.: Authorities have decided to drop charges against about 240 persons arrested during four days of civil rights demonstrations last week.

Atlanta: Civil rights demonstrators picketed the First Baptist Church Sunday to protest the arrest of the Rev. Ashton Jones, an integrationist from California. Jones, currently serving a six-month sentence, was arrested at the church when he attempted to enter with some Negroes.

Public Hearing Set On Freeway Route Near Grants Pass

SALEM — The Oregon State Highway Commission has scheduled a public hearing Dec. 3 in Grants Pass to explain plans for the construction of an 8.5-mile section of new Interstate 5 from Coyote Creek to Jumpoff Joe Creek in Josephine County.

The proposed freeway will follow the general line of existing U.S. 99 in the north-central area of the county. It will connect with the existing four-lane freeway to the south that carries traffic to Grants Pass, Medford, and Ashland.

The proposed construction calls for widening the present highway to four-lane interstate standards, with minor revision of alignment to reduce undesirable curvature. One interchange is proposed on the section and is located where the Leland County Road will intersect. An earlier announcement from the highway department had said the proposed plans to be discussed would include the section from the Douglas County line to Coyote Creek, including interchanges near Speaker Road and south of the town of Wolf Creek. Survey work will not be completed on this section in time, however, and plans for a hearing on it will be announced later.

Highway department engineering and right-of-way personnel will be present in Room 100 of the Josephine County Courthouse from 9 a.m. to noon to explain details of the proposed project to anyone interested. The formal public hearing will start that afternoon in the same room at 2 p.m.

Welfare Recovery Collects \$51,418
