SAN ANTONIO, Tex. (UPI)—Mrs. Jacqueline Kennedy pressed her wedding ring into the hand of her dead husband, seconds before his coffin was closed, Rep. Henry B. Gonzales, D-Tex., said today.

Gonzales described the incident in radio interview on station KTSA.

"She kissed her husband and touched his hand," the congressman said. "She removed her wedding ring and placed it in his hand."

The casket was closed then, and the sorrowful return to Washington begun.
