

**Council Fathers
Thanked for Notes**

VATICAN CITY (UPI) — Joseph Cardinal Ritter of St. Louis today thanked Ecumenical Council fathers from around the world for "condolences and expressions of sympathy" over the assassination of President Kennedy.

Today's session was the council's first since the President was slain last Friday.

Francis Cardinal Spellman opened the meeting by announcing that a pontifical Mass would be said at St. John's in Lateran later today. The New York prelate said he will celebrate the Mass in honor of the late President.

**Unmanned Vessel
Runs Aground**

NEWPORT, Ore. (UPI) — An unmanned 80-foot fishing vessel being towed from here to San Rafael, Calif., broke loose Friday night in heavy seas.

The Coast Guard said the vessel was aground early Sunday and no further efforts would be made to tow it back to port. A Coast Guard spokesman said the vessel, Alten, owned by Thomas Paterson of San Rafael, broke loose from another fishing vessel which was towing it.

It drifted Friday night, all day Saturday and finally went aground in a heavy surf off Coos Bay late Saturday.

'Hot Line' Never Used by Kennedy

MOSCOW (UPI) — United Press International learned on the best authority today that President Kennedy never used the "hot line" to Premier Nikita Khrushchev.

There had been speculation it might have been used between Moscow and Washington during the worst moments of the Autobahn crisis in Germany in October and early November. It was not.

Nor was the emergency communication circuit between the White House and the Kremlin activated when the Russians arrested Prof. Frederick C. Barghoorn on espionage charges. Barghoorn was released after American protests through nor-

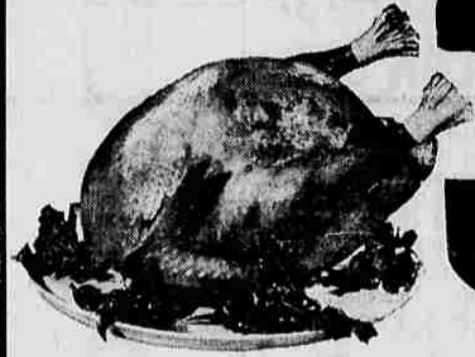
