Gradual Elimination of Most Diesel Firemen's Jobs Ruled by Rail Board

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The Railroad Arbitration Board ruled today that 90 per cent of the firemen on diesel locomotives in freight service and yard engines should be eliminated gradually through attrition.

The ruling was a blow to the Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen and Enginemen which had argued that firemen were needed on diesel trains for safety and efficiency.
