



### Shoes of Leather Make Popular Gift For Long Wear

He'll jump for joy if you give him a pair of leather shoes this Christmas. That's because this winter, leather casuals are constructed of new leathers which combine durability with softness. The cold weather leather casual shoe gives him the ease and walking comfort of summer months — as well as the ruggedness he needs and wants during the winter.

For a holiday romp with the children, he'll appreciate the suppleness and support of a brushed leather chukka boot. Set on a substantial leather sole that absorbs punishment like a sponge, the leather chukka flexes, bends and stretches as he runs with the youngsters. At the same time, the ankle-high boot keeps wind and weather outside the shoe, and his feet warm and dry inside.

Another leather casual that gives him a foothold on comfort during the cold months is the smooth or grained leather slip-on. Usually rising high on the topline, this casual is light without sacrificing protection.

**Leather Moccasins**  
Leather moccasins make a welcome gift at any season — and for good reason. Glove-soft but rugged leathers, roomy toes and foot-hugging toplines, make moccasins as easy as slippers. Slim leather soles add little weight, but offer protection and support on hardwood floors and concrete pavements.

For dress wear during the holiday season, he'll be in step with fashion in leather brogues with medium weight leather soles that are built for support yet cropped for smart styling. Smooth or grained leather brogues come in rounded, crescent or blunted — square toe styles, moccasin fronts or wing-tip-and-foxing.

**Winter Vacation**  
On a winter vacation or just at home with the family, a pair of dressy slip-ons set a tone of ease and fashion. Hand-stitched seams and deeply notched vamps contribute to the snap and style of the dress slip-on. This year's darkened men's shoe colors contribute to the slimmer look of the foot. Most popular are the new burnished olive — a black with green — woody browns and glossy black leathers. Subtle grained leather and smooth leather offer the lighter textures of men's suits, while brushed leather complements heavier textured sports slacks.
