All college graduates and seniors graduating in January, 1964, may apply for the Coast Guard officer candidate school graduating class starting Feb. 9, 1964, the Coast Guard has announced.

Graduates of a 17 weeks training course will be commissioned ensign in the U. S. Coast Guard Reserve. Those who qualify may fulfill their military obligation through this program.

The candidate school is at the Reserve Training Center in historic Yorktown, Va., on the York River.
