

Church Council Moves to Head Off Legal Gambling

PHILADELPHIA (UPI)—The National Council of Churches moved today to head off what it called "an organized effort to extend legalized gambling on a nationwide scale."

A resolution denouncing legalized gambling as an "insidious menace to personal character and social morality" was presented to the council's General Assembly for action at today's session.

Approval was assured. The resolution came to the floor with the backing of the National Council's policy-making General Board and the assembly's Resolutions Committee.

It warned that proponents of legalized gambling are pressing in all parts of the country for legislation authorizing "state and national lotteries."

It called upon churches to "arouse their members" for a counterattack against legal gambling which "encourages a distortion of human and economic values."

Also scheduled for assembly action was a resolution condemning all forms of "extremism" in American political life.

It said the assassination of President Kennedy should awaken all Americans to the dangers involved in permitting "hatred, prejudice, and bitterness" to poison discussion of national problems.

"Extremist groups have sowed seeds of dissension and discord, and Nov. 22, the country reaped part of the harvest," the resolution declared.

"The shots fired on that day had as their target a government of law and order... we cannot allow such a scourge to continue unchecked."

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Ski Patrol Moves Into Training for Work During Year

The Mt. Ashland Ski Patrol is rapidly moving into a schedule of events and training which should have all members ready for opening of the ski season whether it comes early or late, it was announced today.

Many members will travel to Mt. Shasta for the week end to observe the Mt. Shasta Ski Patrol as members go through their tests. They also will attend a training session to be held there.

Dan Bulkley, patrol leader, has repeated the requirements for the endurance test that each patrol member must pass before qualifying as a patrolman.

Persons failing to pass the test will be retained in the organization as trainees but will not be permitted to administer first aid to an injured skier or to bring down "a basket" without the assistance of a senior patrolman.

Advisory Board Named

Bulkley also has named members of the Advisory Board. Serving with him will be Del Johnson, Ashland, assistant patrol leader; Marjorie Simonson, Medford, secretary; treasurer; Toni Geri, Grants Pass, toboggan chairman; and Clint Eckstein, Ashland, first aid chairman. Duke McQueen and Jack Hanel of Medford, and Bill Pruitt, Grants Pass, complete the board.

Ron Ricketts, Medford lawyer, was appointed attorney to draw up the by-laws for the club and McQueen was instructed to write to other clubs for advice.

First aid sessions are progressing into the advanced course and members needing the training were advised to attend the meeting Thursday, Dec. 5, at the Red Cross Building in Medford.

Last Sunday patrol members

went to the new ski area on Mt. Ashland for their first training session in toboggan handling. There were more than 33 members in the group. Training consisted of packing down the snow on the hill by each skier sled stepping up the hill on skis. The portable tow was set in place and each participant started practice in the snow plow position of controlling.

A "controlled snow plow" is important in ski patrol work, the trainees were told. A patrolman must be able to maintain this position for the full length of the slope when bringing down an injured skier in the toboggan.

Practice was focused on the work of both the front and "anchor" man on the toboggan throughout the day.
