California Police Chief Has 'Major' Warrant Problem

NOVATO, Calif. (UPI)—Acting Police Chief Robert Di Grazia is facing a "major" problem. And he has accused the major involved of "action unbecoming an officer and a gentleman."

DiGrazia mailed a \$15 traffic warrant to Maj. Alan W. Saunders of Novato because he failed to honor a \$2 parking ticket issued in San Rafael.

The acting police chief received the following answer from the Air Force major, who recently was transferred to South Viet Nam:

"Dear Chief, "Just received your most welcome notice of warrant. I note that I am to be taken into custody—in Novato, I hope. I can hardly wait. If you need any assistance in obtaining diplomatic clearance to get into Viet Nam to get me, please advise by return mail. Also, if you will let me know what flight your man will be on, I will be happy to meet the plane with handcuffs installed. If I can be of any further assistance, please advise—but do hurry."

Di Grazia described Saunders' action as "unbecoming an officer and gentleman serving the United States," and said he was turning the note over to the Air Force investigation section at Hamilton Air Force Base, with a request that it be routed to the proper authorities.

"You might expect this sort of thing from a private, perhaps, but not a major," Di Grazia said. "He could have enclosed the \$15—and then made his remarks."

Ole Miss Receives Clean Bill from Committee Study

MEMPHIS, Tenn. (UPI)—The South's college and school accreditation body removed a cloud of suspicion from the University of Mississippi Wednesday and ruled there is no longer political intervention in its administration.

The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, which sets the standards required for accreditation, ending the close scrutiny of "Ole Miss" which it imposed after Mississippi Gov. Ross Barnett clashed with university officials over the admission of (Negro) James Meredith last year.

No Violation

"As a result of investigations and after careful consideration of the evidence, the council finds that no overt violation of the principles under question have occurred" since the association was imposed a year ago, the association's commission on colleges said.

However, the commission warned it would continue to watch the school for any indications of political influence in the future.

Ole Miss Chancellor John David Williams hailed the lifting of the surveillance as a clear indication "that the integrity of the university has been maintained."

Dr. E. R. Jobe, executive secretary of the Mississippi Board of Institutions of Higher Learning, said he was "delighted we are no longer under scrutiny," and we are just plain folks again."

According to police, the Doty vehicle left the road at the intersection of Howard Avenue and Mace Road and went into an irrigation ditch. The accident occurred shortly after 11 p.m.

About 8 p.m., vehicles operated by Anna Ruth Scott, 70, of Route 2, Box 29, Jacksonville, and Clarence Edward McLean, 62, of Eugene, collided at Central Avenue and Sixth Street.
