

Holmes Appears Before High Court In Sportshirt

Jackson County District Attorney Alan B. Holmes probably has the distinction of being the only attorney who has appeared before the Oregon Supreme Court in a sportshirt.

Holmes' streak of bad luck started at the Rovey Ann Bowling Lanes in Medford Tuesday night. He left for Salem and the Supreme Court after bowling. At Cottage Grove he discovered his car had been robbed of clothing. The thieves left the suitcase, however.

Then, he stopped at Roseburg for gas and left his wallet containing \$50. When Holmes discovered this later Tuesday night he telephoned state police who found the proprietor had discovered the wallet and locked it up in his cash-register when he closed for the night.

Explains Predicament
The district attorney explained his predicament to Supreme Court members yesterday morning. The court requires a shirt and tie for lawyers' wearing apparel when appearing before the court.

Holmes hopes his bad luck will break when the court renders its opinion, perhaps in January. Jesse James Gilmore, now at the Roseburg veterans hospital, has appealed a six months' county jail sentence for escape. James had escaped from a county farm work detail in October, 1962, but was captured in Dunsmuir, Calif. His original charge was drunk in a public place. He served part of the six months sentence for escape, then was released on bail.

Bernard Kelly, Medford, was representing Gilmore. He originally was appointed to defend Gilmore in Jackson county.

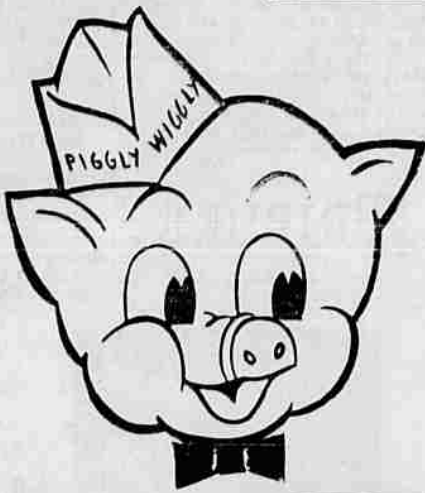
