

First American-Communist Joint Show Being Filmed In Hungary

BUDAPEST (UPI) — East-West tensions have slackened in a very real way along the Hungarian Danube with the shooting of the first joint American-Hungarian film to be completed any day now.

This is the first time that an American company, Cinerama, has teamed with a Communist film company, in this case the Hungarofilm Company.

Technicians for this unique bit of international cooperation are basically half and half. The American producer is Thomas Conroy, while Istvan Steve Nemeskuerty is the Hungarian production half. American Richard Thorpe is the director.

The chief cameraman is Hungary's best, Istvan Hildebrand. Working together with him, separated only by an interpreter, is Cinerama's top sound expert, Fred Bosch.

The stars of the picture are American comic Buddy Hackett and suave George Sanders,

making the 75th film of his long career.

The plot of the story, "The Golden Head", concerns the stealing of one of the Hungarian national treasures, the head of St. Laszlo, from its resting place in the Cathedral of Győr, some 90 miles northwest of Budapest.

Equipment has been pooled for the film. Cinerama supplied the cameras and sound system while the Hunnia Studios sub-

plied the studio facilities and technicians.

Even Czechoslovakia did its part to aid the East-West cooperation. Due to the extra electricity loads needed for the special Cinerama equipment, a 200-kilowatt generator truck was borrowed from a studio in Bratislava, Czechoslovakia.

Both Hungarian and Cinerama officials were agreed that this co-production, the first

American-Communist film, should be merely a forerunner of many others, a furthering of East-West relations.

As Cinerama President Nicholas Reinsel expressed it, "Hungary is not just beautiful women, salami and the Gabor. We want to show the world that Hungary has marvelous talent, beautiful scenery and other things the Western world has never known about."

AMA Votes for Study On Smoking Effects

PORTLAND (UPI) — The American Medical Association's House of Delegates today voted to undertake an all-out study into effects of smoking upon health.

The action was recommended earlier by the AMA's board of trustees.

The AMA said it hoped to find out exactly what human ailments are "caused or aggravated by smoking" and to find out which part of the cigarette may be the villain.

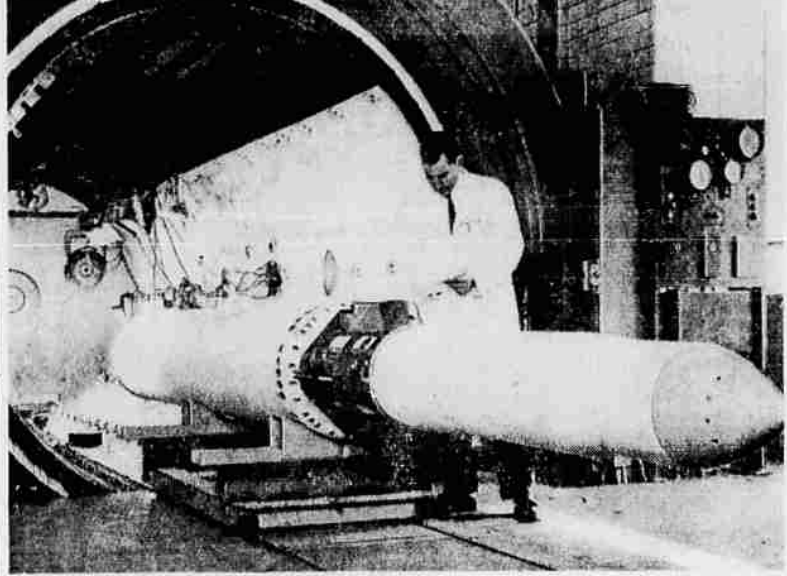
The go-ahead came as Dr. E. Cuyler Hammond, director of the American Cancer Society's statistical research, reported a three-year study showed the death rate among cigarette smokers was more than double that of non-smokers.

Bronze Star Received 20 Years After Signed

DELHI, Calif. (UPI) — Ernest Makita of Delhi recently received the Bronze Star from the Department of Defense—nearly 20 years after the late President Roosevelt signed the citation.

The citation was for "meritorious achievement in ground operation against the enemy in the Mediterranean operation during the Salerno campaign." Makita returned home from World War II in 1946.
