

210 Area Students At Oregon State

CORVALLIS—Just over 8,000 of the 10,426 students enrolled this year at Oregon State University are from Oregon, with the other 2,400 coming from 46 states, 2 U.S. territories, and 66 foreign countries.

Jackson County has 210 students at OSU.

All of Oregon's 36 counties are represented. Benton County is the leader with 1,653 students, followed by Multnomah, 1,498; Marion, 693; Linn, 520; Lane, 458; and Clackamas, 398.

Slightly more than half of the 2,050 students from other states are from California, Washington is a distant second with 241; Hawaii, 237; Alaska, 78; and Idaho, 64.

The 370 foreign students come from around the world. The largest group, 37, comes from China. Thirty-two are from India, 30 from Thailand, 26 from Iran and 19 from Korea. Almost half of the foreign students are enrolled in the graduate school, working for master's and doctor's degrees.

The 10,426 enrollment is a record for Oregon State University.

A breakdown of the Jackson County total shows 132 from Medford, Applegate 2, Ashland 23, Butte Falls 2, Central Point 17, Eagle Point 13, Gold Hill 5, Jacksonville 4, Phoenix 2, Rogue River 5, Talent 3, and Trail 2.

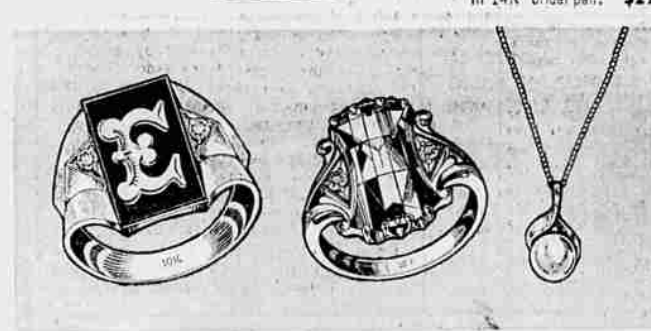

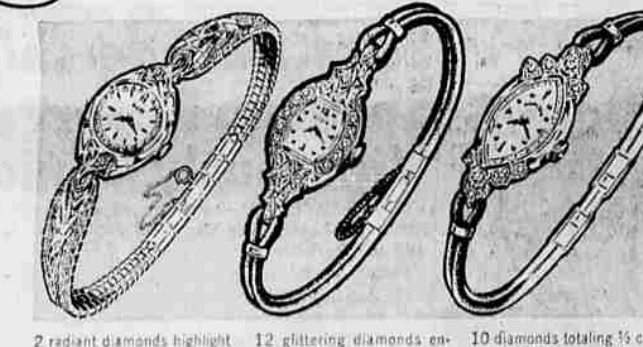
