

Johnson Moves To Aid Studebaker Unemployed

AUSTIN, Tex. (UPI)—President Johnson moved swiftly with a five-point program Tuesday night to aid 8,000 workers idled by the closing in South Bend, Ind., of the Studebaker Corp. plant.

Earlier in the day he expressed a national determination to meet the "unfilled needs of the underprivileged and undereducated."

A statement from the Texas White House said the five new steps were in addition to his Dec. 9 order creating a governmental committee to "do everything possible to help South Bend meet the emergency."

Johnson said he had directed: —Labor Secretary W. Willard Wirtz, under newly enacted provisions of the manpower training law, to establish "the maximum number of training projects consistent with the needs and demands of the area."

—Commerce Secretary Luther H. Hodges to "have the Area Redevelopment Administrator work with the local South Bend community in its efforts to attract new industry to the area."

—Agriculture Secretary Orville L. Freeman to "do whatever is necessary to expedite the distribution of surplus food to the large number of displaced, unemployed workers."

—Defense Secretary Robert S. McNamara "to the extent consistent with sound procurement policies, see that the \$87 million Studebaker military truck contract is completed in South Bend."

—The Interdepartmental Coordinating Committee, which he created Dec. 9, to "send to South Bend a full-time official who will remain on the spot to coordinate all federal activities with the officials of the state and local government."

Three-Year Study Planned on Youth

NEW YORK (UPI) — A three-year research-action study on the attitudes of Israel's youth toward their Jewishness and toward Jews outside Israel was announced by the American Jewish Committee and the Hebrew University.

The joint research project will examine a broad sample of youthful Israelis, aged 18-25, both in and out of school.

The committee said the study will seek to learn in a systematic manner how Jews see their relationship with Jews in other countries, what "being Jewish" means to them, what the "bases" are of their Jewish identification, what the "attachments" are for Jews elsewhere, and how they view the role of Israel in Jewish life.

Maryknoll Priests Discuss Events

PUNO, Peru (UPI) — Forty Maryknoll priests met here recently to explore developments in the "spiritual plight" of Indians in the towering Peruvian Andes Mountains.

The meeting lasted two days, and qualifications of catechists, a manual for catechists, and a catechetical school follow in the parish were discussed.

The system of using native catechists to teach Catholic doctrine in the remote Andean settlements began nine years ago. The first Indian catechists were formed in the town of Azangaro by Father Thomas W. Verhoeven, M. M., of Monroe, Mich.

Responsibility Lies In Materialism

SPRINGFIELD, Mo. (UPI)—FBI Director J. Edgar Hoover, in a bimonthly Assemblies of God magazine, charges that materialism more than anything else is "responsible for the observable deterioration in basic morals."

In a feature to be carried in the January-February issue of Campus Ambassador, Hoover tells young people they will have to meet "the shock of coming face to face with wholly different sets of standards, values, manners, and morals from those you have known in the past."

"Materialism, whether on or off the campus, is the greatest danger we face," the FBI director asserts.

Robinson President Of Church Association

NEW YORK (UPI) — Former baseball star Jackie Robinson has been elected president of United Church Men, a central department of the National Council of Churches serving an estimated 10,000,000 Protestant laymen throughout the nation.

The former baseball, football and track star, now the vice president of a New York restaurant chain, will take office Jan. 1, 1964. He will serve in the interdenominational post for three years.

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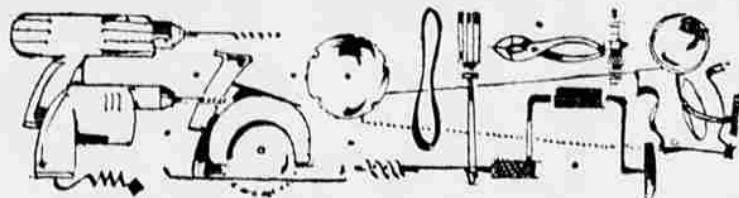


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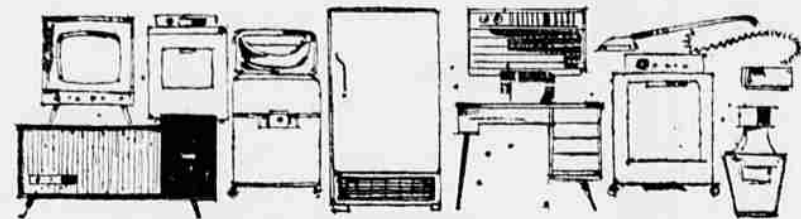
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
