Stock Exchange Going by Rules In Oil Scandal

NEW YORK (UPI) — While the New York Stock Exchange has been moving steadily in its campaign to protect customers of a liquidated member house, it has been going strictly by the rules in coping with a situation for which no guidelines existed. During the pre-Christmas weekend, members were receiving a letter from the exchange outlining its plan by which the exchange expects to recover from its members what it laid out in the liquidation of Haupt & Co. It must be treated as an amendment to the constitution, and the machinery of getting it to approval will take about a month.

There was no provision in the constitution for such a rescue operation as was undertaken by the exchange to help out the customers of Ira Haupt & Co., which was first suspended and then put into liquidation after the failure of a major edible oil dealer, Allied Crude Vegetable Oil Refining Co., to answer margin calls.

Money Offered
The exchange offered to supply an initial \$7.5 million to help out the customers of the Haupt organization, and to come up with \$4.5 million more if needed. Since the payouts already have passed the \$6 million mark, it appeared likely that at least a portion of the second installment may be needed.

The amendment procedure is necessary because the exchange at present is levying at the constitutional limit in its dues and fee structure upon members. The dues are at \$1,500, the limit; the 1 per cent charge on members measured by the net commissions on floor transactions is the permissible maximum; so is the 1/4 of 1 per cent per share on odd lot transactions on the exchange.

Increase Proposed
The exchange proposes to increase these commission charges up to 50 per cent, and the charges would go on until the exchange had recovered its expenses.

When it originally announced its plan to aid Haupt customers, the exchange noted that there was no precedent for its action. It acted in order to maintain public confidence in the exchange and in the operation of the market.

Queen Appeals For Peace on Earth

LONDON (UPI)—Queen Elizabeth II of England appealed on this Christmas Day for men to be truly ambitious for what is good and honorable.

The queen, expecting a baby early in the new year, did not appear on television for her Christmas message. It was a taped in advance for radio broadcast.

"The Christmas message of peace on earth, goodwill toward men, remains the same; but we can only achieve this if we are truly ambitious for what is good and honorable," the queen said. "Humanity can only make progress by determination and concerted effort."

"Once such concerted effort has been the campaign to free the world from hunger... much has been achieved but there is still much to do and on this day of reunions and festivities in the glow of Christmas, let us remember the many undernourished people, young and old, scattered throughout the world."

West Berliners Rush Over Wall

BERLIN (UPI) — The Communist wall gave way today to tens of thousands of West Berliners rushing to spend their first Christmas in three years with relatives in the Soviet sector of the divided city.

West Berlin officials said 45,139 persons had passed through the wall at ground level by 11 a.m. As many as 15,000 more were believed to have made the trip by elevated train.

It was by far the largest single day's turnout since the Communists agreed earlier this month to permit one-day West-to-East visits during 18 days of the Christmas season.

The Western visitors lugged sacks of gifts, bringing with them a sampling of the free-enterprise glitter denied East Berliners, who are not allowed to return the visits.

Alert Procedures Ordered in Cyprus

WASHINGTON (UPI) — The State Department said early today that no orders had been issued yet for evacuation of any Americans from strife-torn Cyprus, but routine alert procedures have been taken.

The department said that U.S. Ambassador Fraser Wilkins had "for some time" been contacting all Americans on the island to advise them about evacuation procedure.
