More Berlin Wall Negotiations Eyed

BERLIN (UPI) — West Berlin and East German officials said Saturday they are willing to negotiate to keep the wall open in 1964 after the current Christmas passes expire.

The statements appeared on the surface to be good news for families split by the wall. But some feared the separate West Berlin-East German talks could undermine the city's legal position and weaken ties to West Germany.

The Soviet Embassy in East Berlin announced Saturday it refused to accept an American protest Friday against the Christmas Day murder by East German border guards of a young refugee.

The Soviet action was in line with the Communist attempt to cut West Berlin's legal ties with the West and build up the Soviet concept of an independent, sovereign East Germany.

More than 70,000 West Berliners used the Christmas passes Saturday to enter East Berlin to visit relatives and a city spokesman said the number today might be as high as 150,000.

Spider Web Reduces Broadcasting Power

COLUMBIA, S.C. (UPI)—A spider almost knocked a radio station off the air Sunday.

Station WQXL was operating at about one-fourth power Sunday morning and three engineers investigated the cause. They found that a spider had spun a web in the housing on a pole outside the transmitter holding the program signal. The web apparently got wet and shortcircuited the line, reducing broadcasts to nearly a whisper.

Nationalist China, Japanese At Odds

TOKYO (UPI) — Japan, alarmed by the possibility of a rupture of its trade and diplomatic relations with Nationalist China, has postponed from hour to hour a final decision on the case of Red Chinese defector Chou Hung-ching.

The 44-year-old Chinese, who defected from a Communist technical mission in October, remained in a Tokyo hotel. He continued to issue demands that he be allowed to return to Red China forthwith.

The Nationalist Chinese government, based on Formosa, was reported considering a complete diplomatic break with Japan — or at least a partial severance of trade — if the Japanese allow Chou to go back to Peking.

Only one more official act is needed to pave the way for Chou's return to Peking. That is the issuance of an exit visa by the Japanese Immigration Service.

Oregon Voters Not Anti Universities

PORTLAND (UPI) — A member of the State Board of Higher Education says that defeat of the 1963 legislature's tax program by the voters Oct. 15 was not meant as a slap at colleges and universities in Oregon.

J.W. (Bud) Forrester Jr., editor and publisher of the Pendleton East Oregonian, made the statement in a speech to the City Club.

"It wasn't a vote against higher education," Forrester said. "They didn't say 'don't spend money for higher education.' If they had, I would fear for the future of this state."

Hggv. er, he said "education in Oregon beyond high school is going to have a hard time this biennium."

Hoffa's Attorney Appeals to Court

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (UPI) — The U.S. 6th Circuit Court of Appeals has been asked to overturn the federal asset seizure of Teamsters President James Hoffa's defense attorney.

Attorneys for Z.F. Osborn Jr. filed the notice of appeal with the U.S. District Court here. The Appellate Court also was asked to study a new trial motion which federal Judges William E. Miller and Frank Gray Jr. overruled.

Osborn, local attorney for Hoffa, was disbarred on grounds he had conspired to bribe a prospective juror in the union leader's upcoming jury tampering trial.

Hoffa and six co-defendants face trial on the jury tampering charges Jan. 20. The charges were placed in connection with Hoffa's conspiracy trial here in 1962 which ended in a mistrial.

Osborn later was indicted on charges of jury tampering in the Hoffa case.
