DUBLIN, Ireland (UPI)—Ailing Irish playwright Brendan Behan was reported today to have spent a good night in Meath Hospital and to have "improved slightly."

Behan, 41, was taken to the hospital early Monday suffering from head injuries and pneumonia after he was found lying unconscious in the road, not far from his parents' home here. He said later he thought he had fallen.

He left another hospital only the day before after treatment for diabetes.

NEW YORK (UPI) - Mrs. Margaretta Rockefeller, wife of Gov. Nelson A. Rockefeller, is expecting a child, it was learned today.

Reports that the governor and his second wife were expecting their first child had been current for some time, but were confirmed today by Mrs. Rockefeller's mother, Mrs. George E. Bartol of Wynne-wood, Pa.

The governor's offices in New York and Albany both said "no comment" to the report. Spokesmen for the governor had previously denied such reports. The baby is expected next spring, perhaps in May.

Three Men Arrested On Local Warrants

Three men were arrested on warrants from the Medford Police Department, one in Crescent City and two in Eugene, according to police.

David Joe Oliver, Crescent City, Calif., was arrested by Northern California officials on a Medford warrant charging forgery, police said.

Orville James Seaton of Eugene, who is charged here on larceny by bail, was arrested by Eugene police on a charge of carrying a concealed weapon and bad checks, police said. Bail was set at \$1,500, and he may be returned to Medford, according to reports.

Federal Stockpile Value Decreases

WASHINGTON (UPI) - Federal stockpiles, including strategic materials and farm surpluses, were valued at \$14.4 billion in October, a decrease of \$119 million from September.

The stockpile report was issued Monday by the House-Senate committee on reduction of non-essential federal expenditures. The group is headed by Sen. Harry F. Byrd, D-Va.

County Court Works On West Side Map

The Jackson County Court is still working on a colored map of the West Side area to show what property owners seek inclusion in a proposed water district.

So far the map shows a check-board pattern which would make establishment of a water district difficult.

The map shows that a majority of the property owners on Freeland Road north of Beall Lane have signed a petition favoring the water district. Property owners on the road south of Beall Lane apparently do not favor a water district.

One property owner on Freeland Road said the area does not have any water or sewage problems and the property owners are not seeking inclusion. The Freeland Road property owners merely signed the petition to help people in the West Side area who do have water problems, particularly the West Side School.
