**Transportation With The Nehalem County The Principal Problem.**

Columbia County, with 100 miles of river front, matchless forests, coal fields and quarries of paving stone, presents a vast field for the investment of capital.

The dairy industry is rapidly being pushed to the front. In the vicinity of Scappoose, 30 miles from Portland, there are several large dairies of the most approved methods, in some of which the herds of blooded stock number 100 head. Breeding of fine stock is of late years receiving the attention of many of the ranchers.

There are several saw mills, some of which have a capacity of from 50,000 to 75,000 feet per day. The cord wood industry is an item of no small moment, there being 10 flumes from the mountain top to the Columbia River front, with an average capacity of 700 cords each per month.

The logging industry is increasing. Several logging roads of from three to five miles in length are now in successful operation.

Coal, iron and building stone are found in paying quantities, but the mines remain undeveloped for lack of transportation facilities and capital to work them. Gold and silver bearing quartz has been found, but not in paying quantities.

Taking it all in all, Columbia County is slowly increasing in wealth and population. The acreage of tillable lands, manufactures, agricultural products and live stock, each increased about 10 per cent last year.

To a man with limited means, this county offers special inducements. While homesteads are all gone, desirable ranches and fruit lands can be purchased at reasonable figures.

Real estate transfers are normal, but with the construction of the proposed railroads into the interior, they will greatly increase. These roads will start up several branches of industry, notably the opening of the Pebble Creek coal fields, new shingle mills and saw mills for the manufacture of cedar lumber, besides giving an impetus to dairying in Nehalem, a country well adapted to that business, and to horticulture. The interior of the county seems to be well adapted to the raising of fine fruits, especially apples, prunes, pears and quinces.

When the transportation question is settled and all parts of the country are in close communication with Portland, we shall have all that could be desired to insure a permanent and lasting prosperity for those who are willing to do their share.
