The Review frankly says that there are evils in the town that have not mention for fear of losing two columns of saloon ads. It does not propose an occupation tax, or town ordinance that exempts either printers from Cowlitz county or lawyers from Portland who come to Rainier for the sake of the change—in hard cash, while every other decent business in the town pays its occupation tax to foster a few saloons, gambling houses, and the little red logging house back of the Dix block. Did you ever stop to consider? The Review must know that the saloons do not pay one cent of the occupation tax of the town, the occupation tax ordinance requires only people who are engaged in decent occupations to pay such tax. What the saloons pay to the town they are compelled to pay by the state law. Remember also that the saloons are making more money than any other class of occupations, and can easily pay a much higher license. Their slot machines alone make them a handsome income. Raise the saloon license to \$1000 and no occupation tax, and additional property tax will be needed—especially if the council will discharge a city attorney and cause the people asking franchises to pay for the printing of their franchises.
