| Little Farms in Japan. <br> Japan, and not France or Belgium, would appear to be the land of petite culture. According to a recent American bulletin a couple of acres is con- sideted a large tract for farming purposes. Most of the farms are smaller, and on a little plot a surprislng varlety of crops is cultivated-a few square feet of wheat, barley, maize and millet; a plot of beans perhaps ten feet wide by twenty feet long, a similar area of potatoes and peas and a patch of onlons "about as blg as a grave;" beet- root, lettuce, turnips, sweet potatoes and other crops occupy the rest of the area. The farmer examines his growIng crops every morning, Just as an en- gineer Inspects his machinery, and if anything is wrong he puts it right. If a weed appears in the bean patch he pulls it up: if a hill of potatoes or anything else fails it is at once replanted. plants another. As soon as one crop is harvested the soll is worked over, manured, and forthwith resown to another crop. It is estimated that ninetenths of the agricultural land of Japan is devoted to rice, and as this is a crop requiring much wh. er the paddy fields are banked up Into terraces, one above plots twenty-fire feet or thirty feet square, with ridges of earth between them to prevent the water from flowing a way when they are flooded. All farming lands are irrigated by a system that is a thousand years old. Some of the ditches are walled up with bamboo wicker work and some with tiles and of Japan is engaged in agrlculture.
