

DUST AND RAIN DO BIG DAMAGE

Sunday afternoon the cities of Spokane and Pendleton were visited by one of the worst wind and dust storms ever experienced in the Northwest.

The city was shrouded in complete darkness and for ten minutes it was impossible to distinguish objects five feet distant, even in houses well protected from the dust.

Nearly all dry goods merchants will lose heavily, as the dust collected a quarter of an inch thick in the stores, soiling merchandise.

The storm reached Spokane at 7 o'clock, where it played similar pranks, crippling the electric light system, telegraph and telephone service, and smashing windows in all directions.
