

MORSE PARTY IS HAVING GOOD TIME

L. E. Morse, who left here on July 25th, on a driving trip to Eastern Oregon writes the Glacier that the party arrived at Mosier Saturday night of that date and went into camp with the wind blowing at forty miles an hour.

Continuing Mr Morse says that "We ate lunch on Tygh Ridge and camped on the night of the 30th at White river and had rabbit for supper. The town of Dufur is an up-to-date town. The country from Eight Mile to the top of Tygh Ridge looks quite prosperous, but from Mosier to Eight Mile does not impress one very much."

Bought Duplex Extension Group.

The rich prospects in the camp of Searchlight Nevada, are continuing to fall in to strong hands. Among the latest deals that is causing great interest at Los Angeles is the purchase of the Duplex Extension group, consisting of four full claims, adjoining the Duplex mine and on the same mineral lode.

The Pacific Coast Mines Bureau, purchased this group from the original owners, Moss, Allison and White, for the large sum of \$50,000, with a cash payment of \$10,000.

This property is the extension of the rich and resourceful Duplex mine that was purchased by John Brockman and Count James Fortaine six months ago for the sum of \$250,000.

The Duplex is now taking ore out of four shafts, shipping daily, milling and running their immense cyanide plant.

The Duplex ledge enters the Extension ground in all of its strength and richness and mining men here who have examined the property and are thoroughly familiar with the Duplex and also the Extension property, express the firm conviction that the larger ore shoals will be uncovered upon the holdings of the new company.

This late deal has stirred representatives of the eastern and western investors located in the camp and the extension and nearby ground of the Extension company is now greatly in demand and being sought for.

Los Angeles capitalists are doing considerable toward developing this part of Nevada and their latest investments will probably rebound to their credit.
