

Through the assi. t-ance of George W. Simons, of the Pa-cific Bridge company, of Portland, who came in on an evening train and knew Maxwell, he was induced to go to The Dalles with Deputy Sheriff Schmeltzer, on the ruse that he was going there on business connected with his profession. He was taken there on the late train Saturday.

The physician who examined Max-well stated that he is almost in a state of mental collapse, having every indi-cation of progressive paresis and that he thinks he is beyond recovery. Mr. Huber, who came to Hood River Sat-urday, when informed of Maxwell''s and the showing a decline in his mentality for several years, but that until lately he had been abe to attend to office work. Some weeks ago, he said, it was necessary to place him in St. Vincent's hospital for treatment for alcoholism. 
