INTERSTATE FAIR IS BIG SUCCESS

Under the most promising conditions in its history, says the Spokane Review, the thirteenth annual Spokane Interstate fair opened last Tuesday and will continue for two weeks.

Fully 14,000 people had passed through the turnstiles during the day and standing room was at a premium on cars leading to the fair grounds.

The main building is filled to overflowing with the exhibits of fruit. The Cheney Commercial club has a fine exhibit of fruit and hay.

More than 300 animals are entered in the four principal departments of the livestock exhibit, including 140 cattle, 50 horses, 70 sheep and 40 hogs.

By day and night the home industry building is in the center of attraction. One of the most interesting features of this building is the hatching of chickens.

The midway consists of 15 different shows, of which the circus is the most pretentious. Probably the most interesting exhibits are the baby incubator, in which are two thriving babies.

Probably the hit of the afternoon on Monday was the tracking of the fake murderer by Parry Draper's bloodhounds.

About 8,000 people paid admission into the fair Tuesday, an amount slightly more than 8,000 last year.
