HOOD RIVER FAIR
WILL OPEN TODAY
EVERYTHING READY FOR VISITORS

Doors Will Swing Outward at 1:30 O'clock White Band Plays and Babies Gargle.

Hood River's Seventh Biennial Fruit fair will open today under more favorable circumstances and with a finer display of fruit than ever before. Visitors from far and near have already arrived and more are expected on each train.

The city is tastefully decorated for the occasion, merchants, business houses and private dwellings vie with each other to see who can make the most attractive display. The fair building, with its neatly whitewashed front, on which is a large sign announcing the place of exhibit, has been decorated very nicely to the hand of the decorator and presents an attractive and gala appearance both inside and out.

All day yesterday and this morning ranchers have been busy bringing in their apples and placing them on display. Exhibits can be seen from White Salmon, Mosier and LaGrande as well as Hood River, the manager of the Fruit Growers' union from the latter place asking permission to send a display which was granted. The ladies who have charge of the display of fancy work and other things pertaining to their part of the fair have been hustling about getting things in shape to make a conquest, and promoters have been polishing their youngest born for the baby show, the prize for which will be awarded this afternoon.

Gaily decorated booths, smiling faces and boxes of red apples accounted by a burst of music which greeted the fair patrons when the doors opened at 1:30 today, for every body is in good humor over the fine showing of fruit and the sure indications of a big attendance to gaze upon the apples that have made Hood River famous.

The irrigation association will be called to order at the same hour that the fair is opened and it is expected that there will be in the neighborhood of 100 delegates present. Some of them have already arrived and more will come in today and tomorrow. An attractive and varied program has been arranged for entertaining them and it is expected that they will hold a business session, both this afternoon and evening, and be entertained tomorrow and tomorrow evening.
