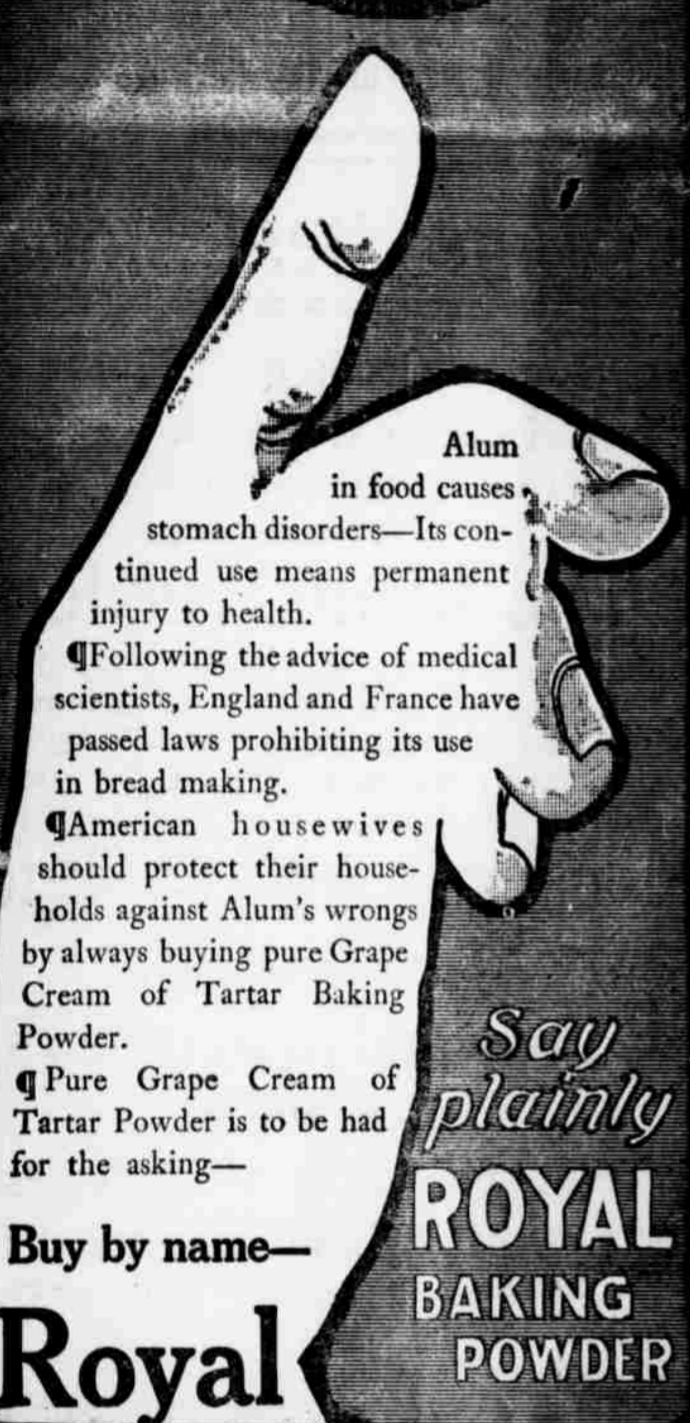

The pupils of the town school, under the ablest instruction of their teacher, Miss P. Olmstead, are planning an entertainment and basket social to be given at an early date.

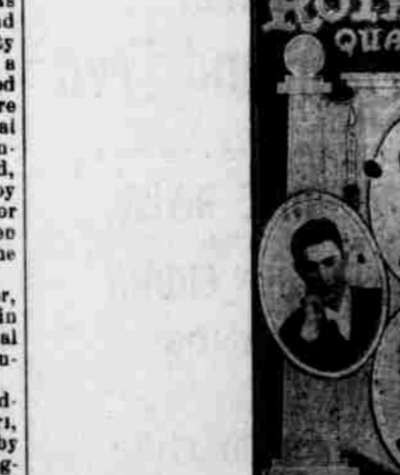
The proceeds are to be used to purchase a drum for the school.
