

REGULAR MEETING OF CITY FATHERS

The regular meeting of the common council was held Monday evening, with all present except Councilman Arnold, who was out of the city.

Monthly reports of officers were referred to the finance committee. J. B. Hunt asked permission to erect an addition to his paint shop, in accordance with the ordinance.

A discussion arose as to whether the ordinance allowed an addition to wooden buildings in the fire limits and it was stated that two such similar additions had been built in the same block and the ordinance did not seem to cover that point, as it did not increase the fire risk.

The petitions for and against bonding the city to bring in the Tucker street were reported to the committee, who stated that they found that thirteen names were on both petitions and each petition was strong enough to defeat an election, if called, and the matter was laid on the table.

Ordinance No. 151, making the assessment for building sewer district No. 2, was passed. J. T. Holman was present and protested against building the sewer without taking all property west of him in the block.

Bids were received from W. G. Aldred and O. B. Hartley for grading all property on West State street which had not already been let by private contract at 25 cents per yard.
