Since most of the fishing is done at night, this practically means no fishing in the navigable channels of the Columbia. It prohibits absolutely fishing in the Columbia at any place between October 1 and December 31.

Neither of the bills affirmatively declares that it shall be unlawful to fish at any place, so that the prohibitory provisions of one bill do not conflict with the exceptions of another, and all the clauses making certain classes of fishing unlawful are effective.

Since both the upper and lower Columbia fishing interests have been hard hit by the enactment of the two laws, it is quite likely they may try to get together on some reasonable legislation before the legislature convenes...
