

GAME LAWS FOR HUNTING SEASON

The hunting season opened July 15, when it became lawful to shoot buck deer. The law gives hunters having licenses the right to shoot five buck deer between these dates, except in Baker, Coos, Curry, Grant, Harney, Malheur, Umatilla, Union and Walla-walla counties.

The season for female deer does not open until September 1 and closes October 31. Does may be hunted during this time except in Baker, Coos, Curry, Grant, Harney, Malheur, Umatilla, Union and Walla-walla counties.

The open season for elk is between September 15 and October 15. Only one may be killed by one hunter in a season. China pheasants, native pheasant, grouse and quail may be shot between October 1 and November 30.

The silver-grey squirrel may only be hunted between October 1 and December 31. It is always unlawful to offer for sale, barter, exchange, transport or ship beyond the boundaries of the state of Oregon any deer, moose, etc.

It is unlawful to hunt without a license, to kill beaver or spotted fawn, or to run deer with dogs. Night hunting is also prohibited by the Oregon laws.

China pheasants may be killed in Jackson county at any time. Female deer may not be killed in Coos and Curry counties, and it is against the law to kill quail or Mongolian pheasants in Grant, Harney, Gilliam, Umatilla and Wheeler counties until January 1, 1912.

SHIPPERS REPORT ON APPLE CROP

The Chicago Produce News says: "Already the Executive committee of the International Apple Shippers' Association has sent out a report on apple conditions throughout the country generally."

"The report which is a preliminary one shows a larger crop throughout the country than last year. All reports from the Pacific coast show that there will be two and one-half times as many apples produced as were harvested last season.

"Considerable stress is laid upon the condition of apples in New York state, which is the great factor in the apple trade. Along the Hudson River the prospects are not quite so good as they were this time last year, but in the western part of the state, including Orleans, Niagara, Wayne and other counties in the apple sections, the June drop was small and the prospects for the coming season are flattering.

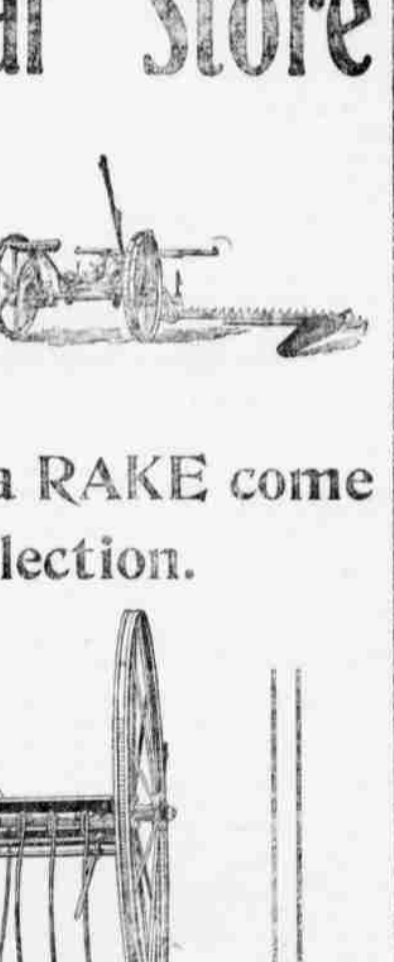
