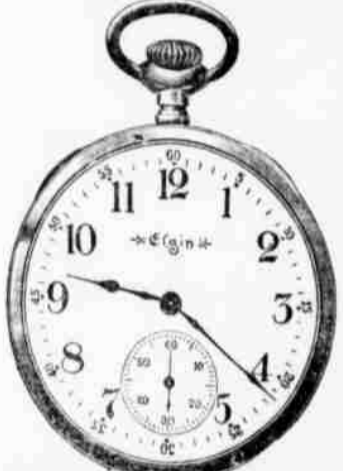

**Leaves for the Jungle in March**  
From an excellent authority the New York Times learns that President Roosevelt plans to leave New York on March 13, nine days after the inauguration, by steamer Koenig Albert for Naples, where the liner is due on March 25.

Besides his son, Kermit, who will take photographs of the big game in Africa, he will be accompanied by a professor from the Smithsonian Institution and an official from the navy department.

From Naples Mr. Roosevelt and party will travel by steamer to Mombassa via the Suez canal and Aden, a sea journey of 17 days, including stops.

So far no arrangements have been made for the six months' party will spend in Uganda province, between the coast and Port Florence, a distance of 500 miles. On Lake Victoria the party will embark for Entebbe, in central Africa. One thing is certain, Mr. Roosevelt will not enter the Congo territory.

President Roosevelt has received an invitation from Mr. McMillan, nephew of the late Senator James McMillan of Detroit, who owns 50,000 acres of forest mountain jungle, etc., in the Nairobi district of Uganda, to shoot over his estates and use the shooting boxes that have been erected in various sections where big game is found.
