With William Dutcher, president of the National Association of Audubon Societies, there will serve on the committee Edward Howe Foraker, who is in charge of the association's New England department, I. Gilbert Pearson, the head of its offices in the South, Frank M. Chapman, a leader in Audubon field work and Dr. I. S. Palmer, who is prominent in the government Biological Survey, the Department of Agriculture as well as an active member of the Association. With the assistance of two authorities at Washington this committee hopes to be able to show the people of the United States some striking evidences of the effect of bird butchery upon their own resources.
