## PLANS TO GROW THOROBRED APPLES

Growing thoroughbred apple trees to be registered in the same live stock with pedigrees, is an innovation in eastern Washington. H. M. Lichty, an orchardist in the Yakima Sunnyside, district, west of Spokane, has perfected a plan to place the science of growing commercial fruit of the highest quality and color and uniform size upon a practical basis.

Explaining his plan, Mr. Lichty said that in every thoroughly cultivated apple orchard there are trees which stand out for yielding most of the prize winning fruit at national and state shows. Scions are taken from these and transferred to other trees by budding and grafting, thus raising the quality. The trees are recorded upon an orchard plat, then registered and a pedigree is issued to the grower.

Professor W. S. Thornber, head of the horticultural department at the State of Washington college, Pullman, and growers in the apple belts in eastern Washington and elsewhere, approve of the Lichty plan, the former saying that the products of healthy trees may be improved by budding and grafting from superior stock. He added there is just as much difference in apple trees of the same variety as there is in horses of the same breed. The plan of registering trees and keeping a record of yielding performances is also endorsed.

### Wasco Farmers Form Union.

Representatives of the various farmers' telephone lines of Wasco county met last week to perfect the Farmers' Telephone Union.

There were about 25 men at the meeting, 14 of the 20 lines in the county being represented. In resolutions adopted it was stated that the union was formed because of the action of the Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Company in adopting a graduated scale of raising the price of service at their central office, and the farmers will withdraw from the company's service unless satisfactory concessions are made.

**New Boat Line Started.**  
Articles of incorporation were filed at the County Clerk's office in The Dalles Saturday by Captain Charles Nelson, Thomas Shepherd and John Featherston, for the purpose of forming the Peoples Navigation Company, the object being to build and purchase steamboats, and to operate them on the Columbia and Willamette rivers, between Big Eddy and Portland, and also build lease and purchase wharf boats and derricks for the same purpose.

The principal office of the company will be at The Dalles. This corporation has recently purchased the large steamer Tolson, which now makes daily runs on the Columbia between The Dalles and Cascade Locks, instead of the George W. Simons, the latter boat having become too small for the increasing business of its owners.
