IN WHAT STATE IS HOOD RIVER IN

"Yes," said I.

"No, we have no Oregon apples," was his reply. "We have the best apples in the world on our stand across the street. They can be identified what you call it—Oregon apple all to smitheeves."

"What are they called?" I asked.

"Why," and here he looked sympathetically at me as if pitying me for my ignorance, "they are the Hood River apple."

"I did not even enlighten him," concluded Mr. Beach.

Goldwaite place near Tucker's, is in charge of the display, which is being made from a carload of apples bought from the Apple Growers Union.

ONE SPITZENBURG FEEDS 24 PUPILS

In times of famine Hood River Spitzensburgs might prove a good substitute for the loaves and fishes of Biblical story, according to the way one was used to feed a crowd of Philadelphia school children. A short time ago Wilbur Hoyt, small son of C. D. Hoyt, who recently came here from Philadelphia, where he had been employed in the United States Mint and bought a ranch near Summit, sent a big red Spitzensburg back to his former school teacher, in the Quaker city.

The lad received a letter thanking him for the apple a few days ago and the teacher said that the apple had been cut into pieces and 24 of his former school mates had feasted on the Hood River fruit. This sets a record for spreading an apple thin.

Specializing in Apple Growing.
W. A. Taylor, pomologist of the United States Department of Agriculture, advises specializing in the orchard business as practically necessary to success. He states broadly that, so far as his knowledge extends, no effort to combine fruit raising in a commercial sense with general farming has proved successful. That is to say, in all such attempts the orchard has been swallowed up, so as to speak, in the grainfields, meadows and other adjuncts of general farming. Sooner or later the tree crop has been sacrificed to the truck crop, the cereals, the grass or the livestock. The owner, having fallen into slack methods in caring for his orchard, the trees became nonproductive as far as marketing fruit was concerned and the effort to raise fruit relaxed and was finally abandoned. The owner, under these conditions, believes firmly that fruit raising does not pay.

The Willamette Valley abounds in evidences of the facts herein set forth. There is, it may be said in defense of the delinquent orchardists of this section, good reason for the decadence of pioneer orchards in the fact that when these gnarled, mossgrown, pest-infected trees were young, vigorous and free from fruit tree pests and bore the finest of apples in great abundance and with relatively little care, there was absolutely no market for their product.

Apple growing with its wonderful possibilities fell into decline in the early years only to be revived after it had become a science, through the necessity the later years developed of fighting pests that prey upon orchard trees and find lodgment in their fruits. Transportation facilities preceded this development and indeed made it possible. Then the wonders of the Hood River valley in fruit culture were disclosed.—Oregonian Editorial.


