NEW MINERAL SPRINGS BEING DEVELOPED

William Stewart, the west side rancher, has just returned from Blockhouse, Wash., where he is interested with L. H. Baker, in a new mineral springs sanitarium. It is located seven miles northwest of Goldendale, has ideal surroundings, and promises to be a very popular resort, rivaling Collins or Shipper's. A new three-story hotel has just been completed, and will be opened for business this month. Mr. Stewart is very enthusiastic over the proposition. He says the water has been analyzed and found to be superior to either Collins or Shipper's in mineral qualities, and is slightly warm, but not hot. A geologist who has examined the spring thinks that boiling water can be secured at a depth of 50 or 75 feet. The spring flows 35 gallons a minute, which can be doubled by sinking and controlling the flow. Mr. Stewart will rent his ranch here in the spring and take up the active management of the sanitarium with Mr. Baker. They consider their property worth \$75,000 and expect to make it one of the popular health resorts of this section of the country.

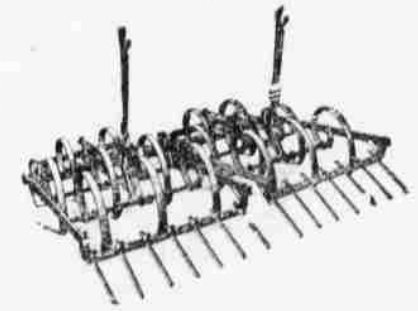
