### FRANCISCAN ORDER PROGRESSES HERE

The following excerpt from a recent ssue of the San Franciscan Monitor, a an active progress of the Franciscan order in this vicinity:

Upon the urgent invitation of the Right Rev. Charles J. O'Reilly, D.D., the first Bishop of Baker City diocese Oregon, the Franciscan Fathers ok charge of Hood River, Hood River ounty, Oregon, and missions in Hood liver County in the year 1906. The ery Rev. Fr. Theodore Arentz, O. F. then Commissary Provincial on the Pacific Coast, and Rev. Fr. Maximilian Glein, O. F. M., to be local superior and pastor, arrived in Hood River, c., September 7, 1906. The Sunday lowing being the feast of the Holy Resary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Rev. Pastor, Father Maximilian Klein, O. F. M., conducted the first parochial service, after having been attroduced by the present Vicar General of the Diocese of Baker City, the Right Rev. Monsignore A. Bronsgeest, paster of The Dalles, who had attended

A neat little church, 62 by 26, had seen built during the year 1905, but remained more or less unfinished on the inside. At once the inside finishing vas begun by the Rev. [Pastor, new and neat altars were made by Bro. Quirinus Kremer.

On the 8th of December, 1906, the feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the church was dedicated by the Right Rev. Charles I. O'Reilly, D. D., as the Immaculate Church, standing on a bluff on the northwest corner of Montello avenue nd Seventh street.

Immediately after the arrival of the fathers a nice piece of property, 217 by 200, south of the church on Seventh street, between Montello and Prospec avenue, was perchased. This piece of property faces the beautiful valley of Hood River, extending about seventeen miles towards the south and Mount Hood snow-capped the year aroud. It is a valley of delicious fruit, as strawerries, apples, etc., grow abundantly. A small house, one story, 24 by 24, oking like a stable, was on the place and had to serve temporarily as the iwelling place of the Fathers and

A piece of property toward the city fimits, about one and one-half miles from the church, was bought to be the Catholic cometery. In April or May, 1908, charge of the Catholics in Klickitat County, Wash.,

was given the Franciscan Fathers of Hood River. In August the same year, His Lordship, the Right Rev. Charles I. O'Reilly, D. D., of Baker City, tendered the charge of Harney County, re., to the Franciscan Fathers. The Rev. Fr. Roman Wolf, O. F. M.

retured to Hood River, Ore., in March, 1910, to take the place of Rev. Fr., Aegidius Herkerath, O. F. M., and the Rev. Father Plus Nierman, O. F. M., came to Hood River, Ore., March 31, 1910, to succeed the late Rev. Fr. Piacidus Kreeler, O. F. M. In spite of the difficulty

the small congregation of the Immacu-late Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Hood River, to contend with, nevertheless it was considered obvious by the higher superiors to move the church from the northeast corner of Seventh street and Montello avenue to the southeast corner of Seventh and Montello avenue and have it paved toward the Columbia River and also in addition of a two-story building, 28 v 28, and have church and residence nnected by a hallway. This improve ment meant to incur an expense of about \$4200, a great deal for this small Bro. Quirinus Kremer ongregation. perintended the entire work of surch and residence.
