

RESIDENTS DIVIDED ON WIDENING CASCADE

A petition signed by a number of the residents of Cascade Ave. was submitted to the city council at its Monday night meeting and asked that Cascade avenue be widened. It was moved by Councilman Mayes that the petition be granted. However, B. E. Duncan, who was present at the meeting, stated that the names on the petition did not include nearly all the residents of the street and asked that, in order to hear from those who might oppose a widening of the street, the petition be referred to the Street committee. Mr. Mayes, who stated that he was in favor of widening the street because of the fact that it was now difficult for large farm wagons to be turned on it, and that this process of turning, after the cement curbs were laid, would cause great injury to them where the wheels of wagons would strike them. Nevertheless, he withdrew his motion, and the petition was referred to the Street committee.

Citizens residing on the west end of Columbia street petitioned the council to make an extension of the city water system on that street in order that they might be supplied from that source instead of from the J. F. Buehler system. The latter extension system will soon be put out of commission, at least temporarily, by improvement on the street.

The finance committee reported a letter received from the city's attorney, Judge A. J. Derby, who stated that the bill of Dr. J. K. Locke, which had been presented the city for an operation of John Ryan, who was fatally wounded by Marshal Robert T. Lewis last fall, could not be collected from the city. The Portland surgeon was authorized by the city health officer to perform the operation. This, however, according to the opinion, would not render the city liable because of the fact that the health officer had no authority from the city.

The Fire and Water committee reported that its members had with the city surveyor made an inspection of the buildings which should be provided with fire escapes and that all owners of such buildings not equipped according to ordinance would be notified by the marshal.

An incident that created a titter in the council hall was the report of Councilman Mayes, who stated that he had lost the ordinance which passed its first reading a week ago and which had been referred to him as chairman of the Judiciary committee. Mr. Mayes stated that it was especially embarrassing for him because of the fact that he had so strongly opposed the passage of the ordinance at the previous meeting. It was decided to hold an adjourned meeting of the council Tuesday afternoon, at which time a new draft of the ordinance should be presented to the councilmen by Attorney Derby. However, before the Tuesday afternoon meeting Councilman Mayes found the ordinance.

The street committee reported that the sum of \$1180 had been expended to date on the improvement of the East Side grade, including the \$200 that was paid for property to be used in widening the right of way. This committee also recommended street and sidewalk improvement as follows: Avenue from Fifth street to Fourteenth and on Sherman avenue from Sixth street to Ninth street, the serpentine way from State street and Sixth avenue to its intersection with Eugene street extended east, then on Eugene street west to connect with Ninth street; grading, cement curbs and sidewalks, Thirteenth street from Taylor to county road as well as the grading, Adams street from Thirteenth to Cascade. The committee recommended that Second street from Cascade avenue to the O. W. R. & N. right of way be included in the paving district.

NOTED VIOLINIST TO APPEAR HERE

WE NEED PAPER MILL SAYS GOODENOUGH

Addressing the growers of the valley who were in attendance at the meeting of Tuesday afternoon, W. H. Goodenough, who has had a lifelong experience in the manufacture of the finer writing papers said: At the request of a number of business men I am going to talk to you on a subject, although it is not about apples, which is of the greatest importance. It is concerning the manufacture of finer papers. The Hood River Valley with its pure water and its ideal water site facilities offers an extraordinarily fine location for such an enterprise. My talk will take place at the rooms of the Commercial club next Tuesday evening and stereopticon slides will be used showing every detail of the manufacture of paper, from hand processes as to the intricate machinery.

The lecture mentioned by Mr. Goodenough was delivered a short time ago before the master printers of Portland and created a great deal of enthusiasm there. The subject of the address is "The Paper Making and Why So Called." The views are taken from one of the American Writing Papers Company's greatest mills.

Mr. Goodenough was at one time connected with the Whiting Paper Co. and was for many years connected with a paper plant, where was manufactured the finer grades of paper, at De Fere, Wis. He came to the Middle West from New Zealand in 1880. "I was told then that fine paper would never be manufactured successfully in the Middle West," he says, "but it has been thoroughly demonstrated that such an idea was erroneous. And what was done in Wisconsin can be done in Hood River; for the location is more ideally adapted. Because of the rail and water transportation materials can be laid down as cheaply as in any point in the Middle West. Every year the western users pay the freight rates on envelopes and such forms of papers as the finer bonds and tablets. The past year 100 carloads of tablets alone were shipped to the west. At present there is not a factory of this kind west of the Rockies."

Mr. Goodenough's recent conference with business men has aroused a great deal of enthusiasm and the sentiment has been expressed that by the securing of such a plant, Hood River will be enabled to secure a payroll, which has for a long time been urged, and a factory employing men and women of skilled labor and above the standard of those of the ordinary manufacturing plant.
