## AUTOMOBILES

F. J. Patterson, who with his family has moved here from Portland to enter the real estate business, will also handle the agency for the Warren automobile here. Mr. Patterson has a model of his Warren car for demonstration purposes.

The motor truck is becoming one of the most popular means of transportation in the valley. The Connaway Mercantile Co. has recently added one of the machines to its equipment. It will be used in transporting goods from the city to the store at Odell.

The Tip Top Auto Co. has sold to Ben Lage a new 38 1912 Model Maxwell touring car. This is one of the neatest machines seen on the market this year. It is an excellent hill climber and has a classy finish of body and hood. The Maxwell car recently won the light car 101-mile automobile race at Santa Monica Beach, California, making time of one hour and 37 minutes. The Flanders was second, an hour and 40 minutes.

The Hood River Automobile Association at the recent meeting was re-organized and its name changed to the Hood River Good Roads Association. The new officers are E. O. Blancher, president, and P. S. Davidson, secretary. Capt. F. P. McCan was elected to the board of directors. The other directors are Chas. Hall and J. R. Putnam. The new organization will have for its aim the betterment of roads in all parts of the county.

F. W. Gilbert, secretary of the Spokane County Good Roads association, suggests several new road laws for the consideration of the coming legislature. One of these is legislation for townships so that at least one-third of the road funds shall be expended on drizzling the roads and earth roads. He says a price should be stipulated at which such work should be paid for and suggests that 50 cents per mile for two round trips be the pay, and that the dragger contract to drag the roads whenever told to do so by the road supervisor. A maximum section of four miles should be allotted and every mile a sign be placed at each terminus of the section showing clearly who the dragger is and who takes care of that piece of road.—The Spokane Spokesman-Review.

Pacific highway signs will soon mark the Pacific coast road of three nations, Canada, United States and Mexico.

Definite plans were adopted for immediate marking of Pacific highway from the Oregon-California boundary to the city of Redding near the head of the Sacramento valley at a meeting of the Pacific Highway executive board in Seattle, April 6. This is only a comparatively short stretch of road, the distance being considerably less than two hundred miles, but at the present time it is the missing link in Pacific highway marking and no signs of any kind direct the tourist who may happen to be passing through the country. Some of the worst road on the Pacific highway route is in this northern California stretch.

Sign posting will be done under the personal direction of Frank M. Fretwell, secretary of the association, and the California State automobile association has agreed to pay part of the cost.

From Redding to San Diego signs of the California State Automobile association and the automobile club of southern California are very much in evidence. It is not difficult for traffic of all kinds to easily find its way through the country.

Posting Pacific highway signs from San Diego to Yuma was authorized at the Seattle meeting, but details were not entirely decided upon. It is planned that this work shall be done at the same time as the northern California marking.

Splendid cooperation is shown by county commissioners and other local authorities in forwarding the international marking. Practically every locality in Washington is now at work improving its section of the Pacific highway.

A record run from The Dalles to this city was made last Friday evening by Capt. C. P. McCan in his Alco. The distance of about 25 miles was covered in an hour and eight minutes. Capt. McCan was accompanied by Mrs. McCan, Mr. and Mrs. Robert R. Carter and Henri de Reding.
