### TROOPS JUSTIFIED, DECLARES FARRELL

"The troops who refused to obey the orders of the commanding officer during the maneuvers at Oakville, Wash., were justified," says Harry Farrell, chief clerk at the Apple Growers' Union, who returned last week from the encampment. "I may be prejudiced in my statements, however, for I was a member of the battalion that refused to obey the command."  
"We were out all day Saturday in the mimic warfare. On Sunday morning we were ordered to break camp and march in action. When the action was over we were told to march with our packs back to the place from which we had come that morning. We asked that we be allowed to place our packs on a wagon and have them transported at our own expense. When this was refused we notified, and our officers, who knew that we had been marching since early morning with absolutely no rest with the heavy burden of camp equipment, upheld us."  
"In case of a light march the regular army allows a rest after each 45 minutes, or thereabouts. We had absolutely had no rest. On the return to Oakville, where we had broken camp, we were constantly picking up members of the other two battalions, who were unable to make the distance with heavy loads."  
Troops in action are never made to carry the camp equipment in the first place.

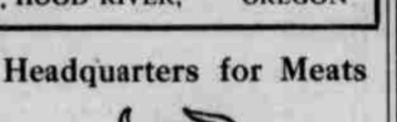
