The taxes on the following advertised real property became delinquent on April 8, 1913, and are subject to a penalty of 10 per cent and interest at the rate of 12 per cent...

Any day after the expiration of six months after the taxes charged against the following real property are delinquent the Sheriff is authorized, upon demand of any person making application, to issue to them a certificate of delinquency upon payment of the taxes, penalty, interest and cost of advertising.

Certificates of delinquency shall bear interest at the rate of 15 per cent per annum from the date of issuance until the certificate is redeemed.
