Other Proceedings
The resignation of E. E. Rugg, Sr., as supervisor of Road District No. 3 was at this time presented to the court and after due consideration it was accepted to become effective at once.

It appearing to the court that there at this time a vacancy in the office of road supervisor in District No. 3, and it further appearing that Roy D. Smith is a resident of said district and well qualified to perform the duties of road supervisor, it is therefore ordered that Roy D. Smith be and hereby is appointed road supervisor of said road district for the remainder of the current term.

The matter of expediting the county's books came on for consideration and it appeared to the court that the books should be expedited for the past year, especially in view of the fact that a new system of accounting is to be installed at the beginning of the year 1915. It is therefore ordered that the firm of Crandall & Roberts be and hereby is employed for the purpose of expediting the county's books.

The viewers' report on the road proposed to be dedicated to the county by Fred S. Holteem was read in open court and ordered passed the first reading.

In the matter of paying Susan Mohr and others for filling a certain gravel pit from which road material had been taken by the county, it appearing to the court that the county has heretofore entered into a contract with said parties for the purchase of gravel and the filling of the pit caused by such excavation, and it further appearing to the court that the consideration for which said Susan Mohr and others will release the county from its contract is much less than the cost of filling said pit, it is therefore ordered and the clerk is hereby directed to draw a warrant in the sum of \$174.75 and deliver it to said parties on the condition that a proper release of said contract shall be executed and filed.

In the matter of allowing an increase of salaries for the various county officials in accordance with Chapter 372 of the General Laws of Oregon for 1913, it appearing to the court that said statute is effective and has been ever since June 3rd, 1913, and it is ordered that the salaries of county officers be and they are hereby allowed in accordance therewith.

It appearing to the court that by reason of the increased number of voters in Hood River County, additional voting precincts should be created, and the December term being the term fixed by law for changing the boundaries of precincts and the creating additional precincts, it is known as Baldwin precinct be divided and that portion lying west of the East Park of the stream of Hood River shall constitute a new precinct to be known as Parkdale precinct. A petition of O. H. Rhoades and others was presented and after considering same it is ordered that the west half of Section 25, township 2 north, Range 10 E. W. M., be set off from Pine Grove precinct and included in Odell precinct. It is also ordered that a certain portion of East Hood River precinct be set off and included in
