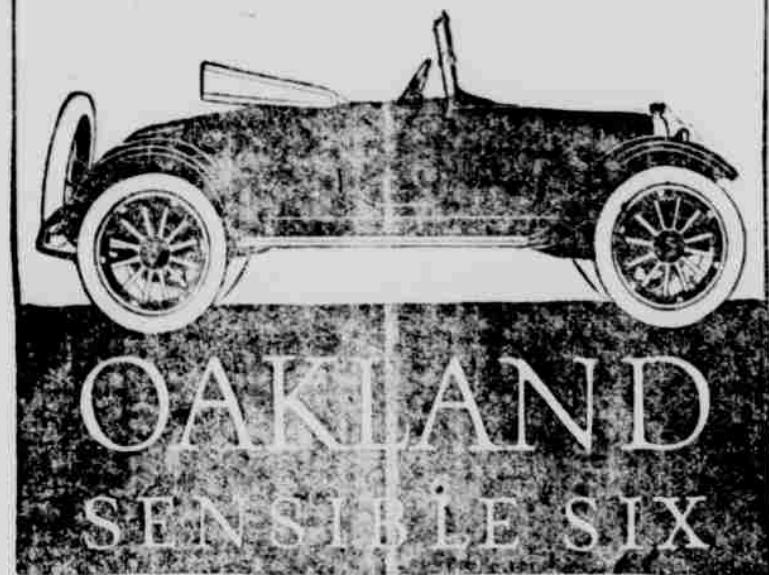

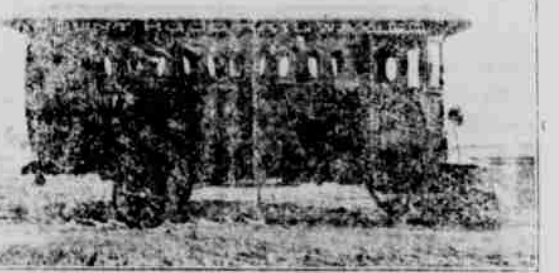

ORCHARDISTS TAKE TO ACCIDENT LAW

Called here primarily to visit numerous sawmills and logging camps just beginning the season's run, G. A. Wood, representative of the State Industrial Accident Commission, has also visited many orchardists who operate their places under the rules of the Accident Commission.

While it is rare that an orchard worker is seriously injured, according to Mr. Wood, numerous smaller injuries have been reported. The rush of growers to avail themselves of the protection of the Industrial Accident Commission resulted chiefly from a law suit here before last in which a harvest hand, whose nose was crushed when a box of apples fell from the top of a ladder on his upturned face, sued his employer and recovered comparatively heavy damages.

Bridge to Be Made Safe. Although a bridge spanning the West Fork of Hood river just above the Devil's Punch, privately owned by an irrigation system, since it is used annually by scores of motorists visiting the scenic point on the river, the county court has agreed to appropriate \$100 toward rendering the structure safe.

F. M. COX ARRAIGNS SYSTEM OF ROADS

Hood River county's policy of road construction was indicted by Frank M. Cox, Chicago attorney, here last week on a visit to his Oregan ranch.

"Because of their condition and the numerous dangerous potholes, the roads are derogatory to local property interests. I have been pretty well all over the United States, but I must say that I have never seen residents of any community drive their automobiles with such reckless carelessness.

"The Columbia River Highway and the Loony Highway are all right in their way. But the Hood River valley must first have good local roads. At present they are a positive financial detriment. These scenic roads are going to be of no benefit to me as an orchardist.
