The best price for a pre harvest sale Mid Columbia apples is reported by E. Slade, whose orchard at Husum, Wash, will yield an estimated 12,000 boxes of high class fruit. Mr. Slade has sold to the Northwestern Fruit xchange for an average of approxi mately \$2,20 per box. Mr. DeLashmutt will also be cusodian of the club rooms.


## Lage's Wheat Sets Record
