

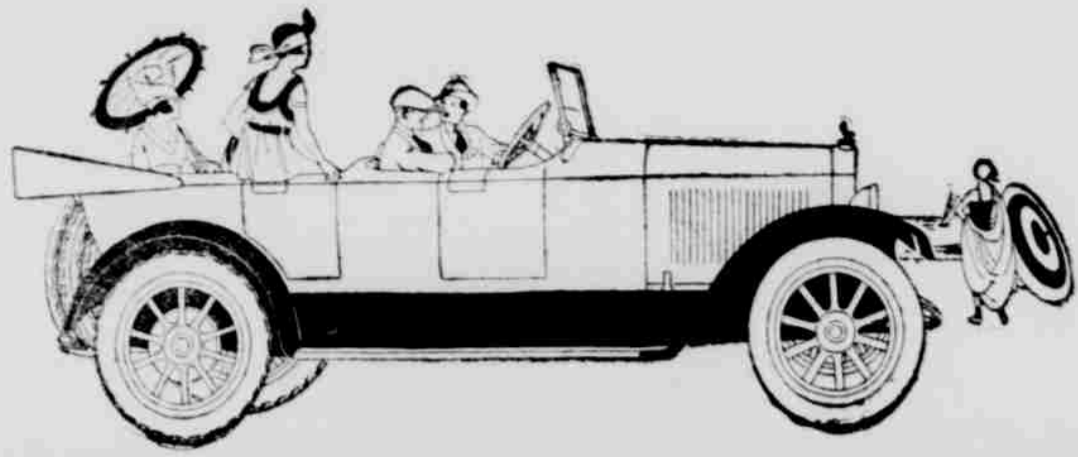

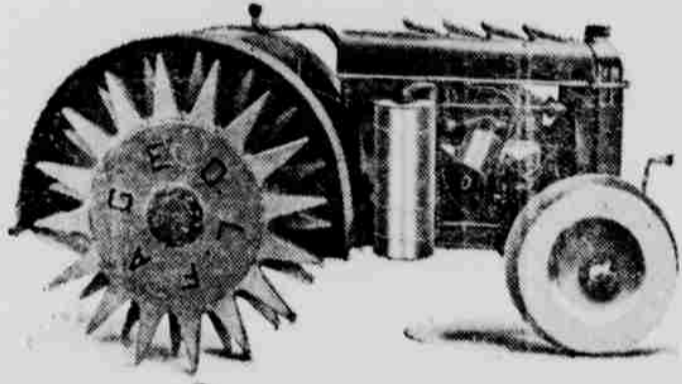

PYTHIAN LODGE TO BUY BIG STRUCTURE

Waucoma Lodge, Knights of Pythias, has voted to purchase the Heilbroner building, the second and third stories of which will be devoted to exclusive club quarters of the fraternal organization. The sum of \$27,000 will be paid for the big building, which was constructed in 1914.

While the Pythians voted some time ago to buy the building, they were unable to enter final negotiations until Saturday, when an option, held by other parties, had expired.

The financing of the new club quarters will be arranged by a system of membership bonds and life memberships held by members of the organization. The lodge is now one of the strongest of the mid-Columbia, having increased its membership rapidly in the past several years.

STRONG DEMAND FOR DODGE CARS
