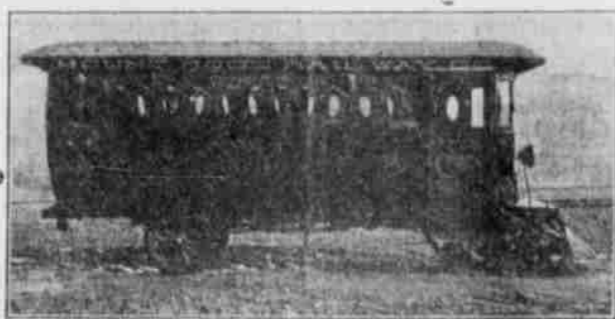

FUNDS FOR WILSON MEMORIAL ASKED

To the Public: The undersigned has been appointed chairman of the committee in Hood River county to raise our quota of the Woodrow Wilson Foundation Fund. This fund will amount to a million dollars, will be raised by small voluntary subscriptions throughout the country, and is established to honor the national and international services of Woodrow Wilson who today is a stricken soldier of the world war. This movement is non-partisan, and the governor of Oregon and the mayor of Portland are honorary chairmen of the state committee. Mr. Wilson will receive no part of these funds, but the income will be used at the discretion of a nationally appointed committee in awards to groups of individuals that in a specified period have rendered meritorious service to democracy, liberal thought, public welfare, and peace through justice.

COLUMBIA GORGE TO SERVE DINNER TODAY

The Columbia Gorge hotel will remain open all winter, according to announcement made by Manager Henry Thiele. Up to this time definite announcement as to whether the hostelry would be open or closed had not been made.
