IS EXPENSIVE TO HANDLE CULL APPLES

The handling of cull apples is an expensive proposition, according to John Peters, of Wenatchee. He would have Peters, of Wenatchee. He would have the grower not grow them at all. I would like to lead the growers over the trail of the cull and show them how unnecessary it is to have them," said Mr. Peters. "It cost a lot of money to handle culls. There is the picking, the hauling out of the orchard, transfer to the warehouse, handling by the sorters, wheeling about by the floor man, loading onto the wagon or truck and hauling to the dump or to the byproduct plant.
"There is expense all along the line.

"There is expense all along the line I would make the growers so disgusted with this trail of the cull that they would grow no more of them. To attain that end necessitates a number of things, such as ample space for the trees in the orchard, special varieties suited to the soil and the location, consistent pruning, plenty of fruiting wood, sufficient thinning, proper irri-gation and spraying, elimination of non-resident owners and the reduction

non-resident owners and the reduction of the acreage per man.

"We have gone decidedly wrong in the Wenatchee district in the choice of varieties for certain soils and locations. Particluarly is this true of the Winesap, which should never have been planted in the upper Wenatchee district, such as the Okanogan country, where this variety does not make size very readily. Planting in the future should be done more intelligently with reference to the suitableness of the variety to the soil and the climste.

"Pruning should be done consistently and should never be drastic. Plenty of

and should never be drastic. Plenty of fruiting wood is needed for one can take off if there are too many apples, but one cannot put them on. In thinning I never use the shears. They are for the feeble only and they have absolutely no place in thinning when done by normal healthy individuals. There are too may apples made culls by the point of the shears touching the apples left on the tree. Removal of the extra apples by the hand is so easily and quickly done that the shears are a hindrance. are a hindrance.

"It is not generally appreciated that by thinning one can get more uniform size on the tree and thus eliminate a great deal of work. One can get 80 to 90 per cent of the apples to go into two sizes and one can then dispense with the sizing machine. I call it the bruiser. By that sort of thinning one can make annual bearing a possibility. "Regarding irrigation, I have noticed that apples that once suffered for lack of water during the growing sea. lack of water during the growing season do not get their normal brilliant color but get a sort of coppery color. Apples that are checked in growth due to the soil getting too dry never recover so as to get the proper color.

"I talked with a man the other day who felt sort of ashamed of himself for owning only 20 agrees of oreherd.

for owning only 20 acres of orchard. The fact is that most orchardists are trying to handle too much land. A man can make a good living for himself and family and have money besides on five acres, If one aims at quality production five acres are enough."


